As per the Regulations notified by the Council vide F. No. 37-3/Legal/2004 dated 14th September 2006 and norms, standards procedures and conditions prescribed by the Council from time to time and based on the recommendations of the visiting Expert Committee and the EC Sub Committees, I am directed to convey the approval of the Council for the Development of a New Integrated Campus with Multi-Discipline in the name and style of Hon. Shri Babanrao Pachpute Vichardhara Trust's Group of Institutions, At & Post - Kashti, Tal - Shrigonda, Dist. Ahmednagar - 414 701, Maharashtra for the academic year 2009-10. The Integrated campus has been approved by the Council for the Faculties as per details given below:

2. The approval is valid for two years from the date of issue of this letter. The Society/Trust/Institution shall obtain necessary affiliation permission from the concerned affiliating University as per the prescribed schedule of the University/ Admission Authority etc. The Applicant Society/Trust/Institution shall send information about commencement of the above courses to AICTE. In case, the Institution fails to commence the above mentioned courses for whatsoever reasons during the two years period from the date of issue of this letter, the approval shall automatically become invalid and the applicant society/trust shall have to make a fresh application to AICTE for grant of a fresh approval.

3. The approval is further subject to fulfillment of following conditions

- That the management shall provide adequate funds for development of land and building and for providing related infrastructural, instructional and other facilities as per Council's norms and standards laid down by the Council from time to time and for meeting recurring expenditure.
- That the admissions shall be made only after adequate infrastructure and all other facilities are provided as per norms and guidelines of the AICTE.
- That the admissions shall be made in accordance with the regulations notified by the Council from time to time.
- That the admissions to the courses shall be made only after the affiliating University /University under whose ambit the institution is functioning / State Board gives permission to start the course.
- That the institution shall not allow closure of the institution or discontinuation of the course(s) or start any new course (s) or alter intake capacity of seats without the prior approval of the Council.
- That no excess admissions shall be made by the institution over and above the approved intake under any circumstances.
- That the institutions shall not have any collaborative arrangements with any Indian and/or Foreign Universities for conduct of technical courses other than those approved by AICTE without obtaining prior approval from AICTE.
- That the institution shall not allow conduct of any unapproved course whether technical or non technical in the premises of AICTE approved institution/campus and for in the name of the institution without prior permission from AICTE.
- That the institution shall operate only from its approved location, and that the institution shall not open any off campus study centers/ extension centers directly or in collaboration with any other institution/ university/ organization for the purpose of imparting technical education without obtaining prior approval from the AICTE.

That the tuition and other fees shall be charged as prescribed by the Competent Authority within the overall criteria prescribed the Council from time to time. No capitation fee shall be charged from the students/guardians of students in any form.

xl That the accounts of the institution shall be audited annually by a certified Chartered Accountant and shall be open for inspection by the Council or any body or person authorized by it.

xii (a) Director: A integrated Director may be appointed from any of the disciplines/subjects of technical education being offered in the Campus as per the norms and guidelines laid down for eligibility and selection procedure.

(b) Faculty: The integrated Faculty should be available in each institution as per the existing norms.

(c) Non-Teaching staff: The Non - Teaching staff should be available as per the existing norms in each institution. A Registrar/Chief Administrative Officer should be appointed to look after administrative activities of the entire campus. A placement Officer should also be appointed to look after the placement activities of all the institutions located in the Campus.

(d) Other Campus facilities: A common Canteen, common Sports facility and Auditorium etc. may be developed in the Campus for the benefit of students of all the institutions located in the Campus

(e) That all the laboratories, workshops etc. shall be equipped as per the syllabi of the concerned affiliating University/University under whose ambit the institution is functioning, and shall be in operational condition before making admissions.

(f) A Central Library covering all the subjects of various institutions located at the same campus with separate libraries located in respective institutions/departments is required to be provided. The total no. of books, volumes and journals should be the sum of all the requirement of department/institutions together as per AICTE norms.

(g) A Central Computer Center for various institutions located at the same campus with departmental/institutional computer centers located in respective institutions/departments is required to be provided. The no. of computers required are rationalized and the computer student ratio be relaxed up to 1:6 adequate number of terminals, Printers, legal software etc. shall be established as per AICTE norms.

xxi That the institution shall furnish requisite returns and reports as desired by AICTE in order to ensure proper maintenance of administrative and academic standards

xxii That the technical institution shall publish an information booklet before commencement of the academic year giving details regarding the institution and courses/programmes being conducted and details of infrastructural facilities including faculty etc. in the form of mandatory disclosure. The information booklet may be made available to the stakeholders of the technical education on cost basis.

xxiii That it shall be mandatory for the technical institution to maintain a web-site providing the prescribed information. The website information must be continuously updated as and when changes take place.

xxiv That a compliance report in the prescribed format along with mandatory disclosure on fulfillment of the above conditions, shall be submitted each year by the Institution within the time limit prescribed by the Council from time to time.

xxvii That if Technical Institution fails to disclose the information or suppress and/or misrepresent the information, appropriate action could be initiated including withdrawal of AICTE approval.

xxviii That a Joint FDR is required to be created for an amount and period prescribed by the Council separately for each institution for from time to time.

xxix That AICTE may carry out random inspections round the year for verifying the status of the institutions to ensure maintenance of norms and standards.

xxx That the AICTE may also conduct inspections with or without notifying the dates to verify specific complaints of misrepresentation, violation of norms and standards, mal-practices etc.

xxxi That the Institution by virtue of the approval given by Council shall not automatically become claimant to any grant-in-aid from the Central or State Government.

xxxii The Institute shall take appropriate measures for prevention of ragging in any form, in the light of directions of Supreme Court of India in Writ Petition No. 656/1998. In case of failure to prevent the instances of ragging by the Institutions, the Council shall take appropriate action including withdrawal of approval.

xxxiii That the Management shall strictly follow further conditions as may be specified by the Council from time to time.

xxxiv That the institution shall provide the following facilities for the physically challenged persons



5.0 Specializations offered: The following specializations shall be offered as MAJOR / MINOR:

1. Marketing Management (MKT)
2. Financial Management (FIN)
3. Human Resources Management (HRM)
4. Operations & Supply Chain Management (OSCM)
5. Business Analytics (BA)

The following specializations shall be offered ONLY as MINOR Specializations:

1. Rural & Agribusiness Management (RABM)
2. Pharma & Healthcare Management (PHM)
3. Tourism & Hospitality Management (THM)

Note:

1. Institutes may offer ONLY SELECT specializations based on industry needs, faculty strength & competencies, student demands, employability potential, etc.
2. Institutes MAY NOT offer a specialization if a minimum of 20% of students are not registered for that specialization.
3. The Institute MAY NOT offer an elective course if a minimum of 20% of students are not registered for that elective course.

5.1 Open Elective(s):

1. Learners who intend to learn specific courses from other specialization(s) can opt for Subject Elective (SE - IL) courses from other specializations in lieu of the Subject Elective (SE - IL) courses from their native specialization.
2. These open electives MAY BE from two different specializations.
3. Open Electives can be opted for only in Sem III and Sem IV.
4. Students can opt for maximum 1 Subject Elective (SE - IL) course in Sem III and Sem IV each. i.e. Students can opt for maximum 2 Open Electives (total 4 credits).

5.2 Major Specialization + Minor Specialization Combination:

1. For a Major + Minor Specialization combination the learner shall complete
 - a) Major Specialization - Courses: Total 9 (4 Subject Core courses and 5 Subject Elective courses)
 - b) Minor Specialization - Courses: Total 4 (2 Subject Core courses and 2 Subject Elective courses)
2. For a Major + Minor Specialization combination the learner shall earn
 - a) Major Specialization - Credits: Total 22 (12 Credits from Subject Core + Minimum 10 Credits from Subject Electives)



- b) Minor Specialization – Credits: Total 10 (6 Credits from Subject Core + Minimum 4 Credits from Subject Electives)
- The 10 credits of the MINOR specialization shall be from a single specialization, out of which 6 credits shall be mandatorily earned through the Subject Core Courses.
 - The Major + Minor specialization combination is OPTIONAL.
 - Students shall be permitted to opt for **ANY Major + ANY Minor** specialization combination, subject to institutional norms and guidelines, issued from time to time.
 - A student opting for Major + Minor specialization combination shall opt for Foundation Courses / Enrichment Courses / Alternative Study Credit Courses **ONLY** in lieu of Generic Elective (GE - IL) Courses.
 - Institutes may stipulate additional criteria of minimum SGPA / CGPA, number of backlogs, expectations about specific graduation discipline for students who wish to take up a specific specialization / specific major minor combination. Such criteria may also involve the potential employability criteria for a particular specialization / Major + Minor specialization combination.

5.3 Options & Guidelines for Choice of Specialization:

- Students can opt for a single specialization (i.e. Major Only – 5 choices)
- Students can opt for a two specializations (i.e. Major + Minor Combination – 1(Major) + 7(Minor) choices)
- Specializations which are offered ONLY as MINOR shall be offered in SECOND YEAR ONLY. (3 choices)
- Courses for the Minor specialization shall be taken up in the second year ONLY (in either Sem III or Sem IV or in a combination of Sem III and IV).
- The Major specialization of a student shall be determined by the Subject Core (SC) courses and the Subject Elective (SE - IL) courses chosen in Sem II.
- All courses (Subject Core (SC) courses and the Subject Elective (SE - IL) courses) chosen in Sem II shall belong to the same specialization.
- The learners shall generally complete 6 Subject Core courses (2 each in semester II, III, IV) and 7 Subject Elective courses (2, 3, 2 each in semester II, III, IV respectively). In this case he /she shall be awarded MBA (Functional Area Specialization) degree, e.g. MBA (Marketing), MBA (Finance), etc.
- The learners shall complete 4 Subject Core courses and 5 Subject Elective courses of Major specialization and 2 Subject Core courses and 2 Subject Elective courses of Minor specialization. In this case he /she shall be awarded MBA (Functional Area Specialization Major + Functional Area Specialization Minor) degree, e.g. MBA (Marketing + Finance), etc.

5.4 Foundation Courses:

- All the Foundation Courses shall be of 1 credit each.
- Maximum credits for Foundation Courses shall not exceed 10 (Ten) Credits.
- Foundation Courses can be opted for ONLY IN LIEU of Generic Elective (GE - IL) and / or Subject Elective (SE - IL) courses.³
- This choice can be exercised in Semester I (minimum zero Credits – maximum six credits) or Semester II (minimum zero Credits – maximum four credits) ONLY.
- Foundation Courses CANNOT be opted for in Sem III and in Sem IV.
- It is NOT MANDATORY for a learner to opt for Foundation Courses. However, Faculty members may advise a student to enroll for Foundation Course(s) after a methodical assessment of the relevant competencies of the student.
- Foundation Courses shall be offered ONLY to those students who lack the basic competencies in the specific course. The institute shall conduct a methodical assessment of the relevant competencies of the student. to identify the learners who need to take up foundation courses. Records of the evaluation shall be preserved.
- Institutes may stipulate additional criteria for students desirous to take up Foundation Courses.
- Foundation Courses shall be taught by the course teacher in workshop mode / project mode.
- The course teacher shall oversee the progress of the learner as well as evaluate the learner for 25 marks / 1 credit.
- Pre- and post-test: A test or other assessment activity shall be administered to the students both at the beginning of the foundation course and at the end of the foundation course, with the intention of demonstrating improved skills upon completion. The tests shall be essentially SKILL based.

Ans:- Concept of financial management.

The concept / term financial management means obtaining & managing funds. And the primary objective of financial management is to increase the firm's value. So what is the concept of financial management? There are 2 basic concepts of financial management: obtaining funds & utilising these funds.

Functions of financial management:-

1] Estimation of capital requirements:- A finance manager has to make estimation with regards to capital requirements of the company. This will depend upon expected costs & profits & future programmes & policies of a concern.

2] Determination of capital composition:- Once the estimation have been made, the capital structure have to be decided. This involves short-term & long-term debt equity analysis. This will depend upon the proportion of equity capital a.

Company is possessing of additional funds which have to be raised from outside parties.

3] Choice of sources of funds :- For additional funds to be procured a company has many choices like -

- a] Issue of shares & debentures.
- b] Loans to be taken from banks & financial institutions
- c] Public deposits to be drawn like in form of bonds. Choice of factor will depend on relative merits & demerits of each source & period of financing.

4] Investment of funds :- The finance manager has to decide to allocate funds into profitable ventures so that there is safety on investment & regular return is possible.

5] Management of cash :- Finance manager has to make decisions with regards to cash management. Cash is required for many purpose like payment of wages & salaries, payment of electricity & water bills.

payment to creditors meeting current liabilities, maintenance of enough stock purchase of raw materials etc...

6] financial controls :- The finance manager has not only to plan, procure & utilize the funds but he also has to exercise control over finances. This can be done through many techniques, like ratio analysis, financial forecasting, cost & profit control etc.
